Tennessee's Healthy Smiles Initiative

Oral health services in Tennessee, particularly among high-risk and underserved populations, need a lot of improvement. Oral health problems can be medically dangerous, but also have important social and economic consequences.

Among low- and middle-income Tennesseans, 40% say life is less satisfying due to dental conditions, and 16% say the appearance of their mouth and teeth affects their ability to get a job, according to the Better Tennessee Dental Health Report Card.

The Healthy Smiles Initiative was created to address this need. This 5-year, \$94 million pilot program aims to expand access to dental care statewide. At the request of Governor

Bill Lee, former Tennessee Health Commissioner Dr. Lisa Piercey convened a group of dental industry stakeholders from across the state in early 2021 to develop recommendations to increase access to high-quality, affordable dental care for Tennesseans. The workgroup, which included dentists, dental hygienists, the state's two dental schools, TennCare, the Department of Health, payors, safety net clinics, and others, settled on a comprehensive set of proposals that became the Healthy Smiles Initiative.

"Too often people treat oral health as a separate issue, and they have to be reminded that your mouth is connected to the rest of your body," said Dr. Phil Wenk, CEO of Delta Dental. "But Commissioner Piercey understood the importance



and urgency of addressing our dental crisis in Tennessee from the start and played a critical role in the development and ultimate approval of the Healthy Smiles Initiative. Generations of Tennesseans will benefit from her leadership."

> The major components of the Healthy Smiles Initiative are an expansion of dental school class sizes, new and strengthened workforce recruitment and retention efforts, and increased safety net funding. Two existing, proven safety net programs will receive a significant boost: the Smile On 65+ program, which provides oral health care and case management services for older adults, and the prosthodontic grant program, which has to date helped provide more

than 2,300 Tennesseans seen in safety-net clinics with low- or no-cost dentures.

"Everything we do at the Department of Health goes back to our mission statement - to protect, promote, and improve the health and prosperity of people in Tennessee," said Dr. Piercey. "The Healthy Smiles Initiative checks all of those boxes - even and especially prosperity - because if you don't have a healthy smile, you may have trouble finding and keeping a job, certainly one that aligns with your skills and capabilities."

It was Dr. Piercey's stewardship of the pilot program that earned her Delta Dental of Tennessee's third-ever Smile Power Award, which celebrates an individual who has made a significant positive impact on the oral health of Tennesseans.

This guide is published by Delta Dental of Tennessee's Smile180 Foundation to help Tennesseans who cannot afford dental care find free and low-cost resources for oral care. This publication offers a directory of free, low-cost and sliding-fee dental clinics located across the state.

About the Clinics in This Guide

Most clinics in this guide serve community members who do not have dental insurance and cannot afford dental services at market rate prices. Many of these clinics rely heavily on volunteer dental professionals and support staff to offer dental services. Each of these health facilities has a unique process for screening payment ability and processing patients.

Although the clinics in this guide aim to offer timely care and meet the needs of all patients, high levels of demand and emergency health situations may cause long wait times. This is especially true for patients seeking non-emergency restorative and routine care (such as dentures or routine cleanings). Potential patients are strongly encouraged to contact more than one clinic to learn more about availability, payment options and wait times for services. Patients should expect to provide proof of income eligibility to receive care.

Types of Clinics

Free:

Free Clinics provide services at no cost to patients who meet income eligibility requirements.

Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC):

Federally qualified health centers (FQHC) are not-for-profit clinics that receive federal grants to offer sliding-fee-scale payment programs for patients who qualify.

Low Cost:

These clinics offer dental services at prices that are lower than average market rates.

Sliding Fee Scale Clinics:

Sliding fee scale clinics allow patients to pay for services on a "sliding" scale based on income limitations.



Helpful Steps for Getting Care:

Each clinic has a unique process for meeting the needs of patients. Using these steps will help clinics meet your needs in a more timely and efficient manner.

1 Call Before You Go: Calling clinics first and inquiring about the issues listed below will help you discover how to best get the care you need and deserve.

Things to ask about:

Eligibility: Most clinics in this guide offer services based on your income and where you live. Many clinics will require proof of income and address. Learning about eligibility requirements by phone can save time and money.

Availability of Services: Learning which services are available and if services have wait periods for processing or receiving care can help you select a clinic and time frame that meets your needs.

How to Make an Appointment:

Although some clinics accept walkins, most clinics in this guide require an appointment prior to service. Some clinics may have specific procedures for appointment setting.

2 Explore Your Options: Contacting more than one clinic allows you to learn what options are available and what screening processes are required to receive care.

Make an Appointment: After

• deciding which clinic is right for you, contact the clinic and follow the clinic's procedures for making an appointment.

Get the Care You Need: After you make your appointment, follow the clinic's procedures for attending the clinic and receiving care. If you can't make your appointment, call or contact the clinic to reschedule or cancel your appointment. This will allow the clinic to meet the needs of other patients who are seeking care.

5 Follow Up: Prevent future dental problems by following the instructions given by clinic staff, attending follow up appointments, and practicing good oral hygiene at home.
