

Re-credentialing at Medicare Standards

ramatic changes in health care delivery have occurred due to the implementation of the Affordable Care Act and the baby boomer generation transitioning into Medicare and Medicare Advantage Programs. It is expected that enrollment in the Medicare Advantage dental plans will continue to grow as individuals with long-standing employer-based benefits retire and learn that adult dental benefits under Medicare are limited.

Over the next several months, Delta Dental of Tennessee will be re-credentialing our entire network of providers to be available for potential partnerships with Medicare Advantage health care carriers. While Delta Dental providers already adhere to most of the necessary credentialing and re-credentialing requirements, there will be a few additional items needed by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to participate in Medicare Advantage plans, including:

- Exclusion from the Medicare Preclusion Lists
- Exclusion from the Office of Inspector General List (OIG)
- Fraud, Waste and Abuse (FWA) annual training (for your convenience, an FWA training program will be available soon on our website)
- Completion of a Compliance Attestation form

Beginning in April 2022, providers can expect information from DentalXChange via the email address provided to Delta Dental to start their re-credentialing process. Once providers have completed the requirements this year, they will be set for the next three years.

isiting the dentist can be an intimidating experience, especially for kids. The buzzing noises and strange tools aren't always comforting, and they can be particularly overwhelming for people with autism spectrum disorder (ASD). About 1 in 54 children are diagnosed with ASD, and some research shows that those with ASD have a higher risk of dental disease. That's why InfiniTeach developed the All Smiles Shine app.

Created in partnership with Project Accessible Oral Health (PAOH) and Delta Dental, the All Smiles Shine app's purpose is to help the autism and intellectual and developmental disabilities communities learn about oral health care, practice preventive care at home, and prepare for an upcoming visit to the dentist. The app's features are designed to help alleviate anxiety and encourage better habits through evidence-based autism interventions and best practices in technology development, as identified by the National Professional Development Center on Autism Spectrum Disorder. By embedding these evidence-based practices into the app, people with ASD and their families, can customize the experience to their needs. Those features include:

- At-home videos that support preventive care practices, a flossing and brushing tracker with rewards, and how to prepare for a dental visit.
- Personalized sensory preferences, interests, and calming tools to share with the dentist.
- Picture schedules, breathing exercises, emotion identifiers and more.
- Caregiver tips and tricks for daily brushing, flossing and healthy eating.

Mouthguards: Essential at Every Age



G ood oral hygiene habits start early, and that includes the use of mouthguards while playing sports. It is estimated that more than three million teeth are knocked out each year in youth sporting events, according to the National Youth Sports Safety Foundation, and it's the athletes who don't wear mouthguards that are 60 times more likely to damage their teeth.

In an effort to help make wearing mouthguards a habit, Delta Dental of Tennessee donated boil and bite mouthguards to youth sports teams with athletes 10 years old and younger throughout the state. Partnering with Special Olympics of Tennessee and a group of local professional athletes, Delta Dental was able to

provide thousands of young athletes their own mouthguard, from Dyersburg to Kingsport, Tennessee. Even the athletes representing Team Tennessee at the 2022 USA Games in Orlando for Special Olympics Tennessee will be able to train and compete with a mouthguard from Delta Dental, proving that mouthguards are essential at every age and ability level.

"I've always worn a mouthpiece ever since I've

played football since little league days," said Tennessee Titans free safety Kevin Byard. "When you talk about concussions in football, when you have a mouthpiece and you have something to bite down on when you're making a tackle or you're making a block, it decreases the chance of you having a concussion. It's very important, so I would encourage everybody to wear a mouthpiece."

"An American Association of Orthodontists survey found that 84 percent of children do not wear

mouthguards while playing organized sports because they are not required to," said Dr. Phil Wenk, CEO and president of Delta Dental of Tennessee. "Think about how every one of those kids is 60 times more likely to damage their teeth."
